ASSISTANT/ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: CLINICAL NURSING

Concordia University, Portland, founded in 1905, is a member of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod's Concordia University System.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the direction of the Nursing Program Director, the professor will:

1. Work collaboratively with CU faculty, staff, nursing advisory committee, and the community in the ongoing implementation and refinement of the BSN program.
2. In collaboration with the professional team, teach nursing classes focusing on integration of nursing knowledge and practice.
3. Actively participate in the process to assure that the program meets the requirements and standards of regulatory agencies.
4. Assist in development of partnerships with clinical agencies.
5. Assume clinical teaching responsibilities as expert teacher and clinician.
6. Coordinate and mentor adjunct instructors in skills laboratory and clinical practice.
7. Assume the same clinical teaching responsibilities as clinical adjuncts but serve as an expert and model in these processes.
8. Commitment to focus on humanity of the patient, spiritual grounding of the nurse, cultural competence, and health promotion.
9. Perform an appropriate balance of other responsibilities, including research and service within the University and community.

QUALIFICATIONS: The qualified candidate will possess:

1. Commitment to the Christian faith.
2. Graduate degree in nursing required. Progress toward a doctorate highly desired; an earned doctorate from a regionally accredited institution preferred.
3. Five years of nursing experience with clinical teaching experience preferred.
4. Eligibility for Oregon registered nurse licensure.

SALARY:

The salary for this position is based on the current faculty/staff salary scale, and will be commensurate with the position and the candidate's educational background, professional experience, scholarship activity and service to the church and the community.

Concordia University will pay full tuition toward the completion of a doctoral degree for qualified applicants. Generous benefits package, including tuition remission for immediate family members.
