NOTES:

1. Transfer student admissions process:

- Submit an undergraduate application for admission (no charge when application is submitted online).
- Submit official transcripts from each college or university attended.
- Submit a recommendation from a current academic instructor or employer/supervisor.
- Priority deadlines for submitting an application:

Fall Semester = August 1st; Spring Semester = December 1st; Summer Semester = April 1st

2. Thirty (30) of the final forty (40) semester hours must be completed at Concordia [excluding credit given by exam and prior learning assessment (PLA)]. At least 50 percent of credits required in the major must be completed at Concordia.

3. No grade below a “C” will be counted toward completion of a major or minor.

4. There are slight variations in course requirements depending upon a student’s major. Contact Concordia University at 800-321-9371 for major specific requirements that can be obtained at the community college level.

5. Quarter credits transfer at two-thirds credit, i.e. 90 quarter credits = 60 semester credits (junior class standing).

Concordia University accepts the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree as meeting general education requirements except for religion and upper division general education. However, the Oregon Transfer degree does not necessarily meet GPA requirements for all majors. **This guide is subject to change and should not be regarded as a contract between Concordia and students attending Chemeketa Community College.
