ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR FRESHMEN APPLICANTS

High school graduates and college transfers with fewer than 12 semester hours may be eligible for admission, provided they have fulfilled the following criteria:

1. Cumulative high school GPA of 2.50
2. A verbal SAT-I of 480 or above, or
3. An ACT composite score of 18 or above.

For high school students completing their secondary education through a G.E.D. program, Concordia University requires a composite test score average of 50, with no single score below 48.

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR TRANSFER APPLICANTS

College transfer students desiring admission to CU may be considered for admission only if they have attended an accredited college or university for a minimum of 12 semester hours in coursework approved by the Registrar.

Transfer students with more than 12 semester hours may be eligible for admission provided they have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Transferable hours that are ten years and older will fulfill applicable course requirements, but will not figure into the student's cumulative GPA.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Submit an undergraduate application for admission.
2. Submit \$20 non-refundable application fee.
3. Request official transcripts of work completed to date be sent to CU. High school students may submit an academic transcript listing coursework through their seventh semester. College transfer students must submit transcripts for each institution previously attended.

4. Incoming freshmen must have either SAT-I or ACT scores sent to CU. The college code numbers for the tests are: SAT 4079; ACT 3458.
5. Request a current academic instructor, pastor, or employer/supervisor to submit a recommendation to CU.

DEADLINES

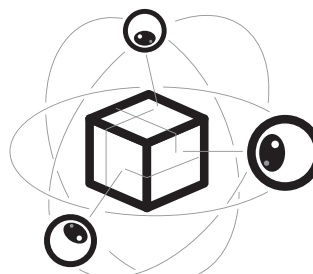
Concordia University has a rolling admission process. However, applications submitted by the following dates are given priority:

Fall Semester	March 1
Spring Semester	December 1
Summer Semester	March 1

APPLICATION DECISION

Students will be notified of the admission decision by mail approximately two weeks after the application file has been completed. When acceptance is granted, the student will receive all necessary forms, including:

1. A request for a \$100 deposit to confirm enrollment. This deposit is applied directly to the student's tuition. For fall semester, the deposit must be paid by May 1 or 30 days after acceptance, if acceptance is granted after May 1. The deposit is non-refundable after June 1. For spring semester, the deposit is due November 1, and is non-refundable after December 1. For summer semester, the deposit is due March 1 and is non-refundable after April 1.
2. Housing Application Form with \$50 deposit.
3. Health History Form.
4. Immunization Data Form (required by Oregon State Law).



FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

HOW TO APPLY FOR NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID (GRANTS AND LOAN ELIGIBILITY)

1. Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). FAFSAs are available from high school guidance or counseling offices, from any college financial aid office or from Concordia University.
2. Be accepted for admission to Concordia University. School code: 003191
3. Submit other documents as requested.

HOW TO APPLY FOR INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Students in Bachelor of Arts degree programs who have been active in their schools, churches, and communities

are welcome to apply for internal and external scholarships awarded by the university. Please note that Concordia University President's, Regent's, Dean's, and University merit scholarships are awarded at the time of admission and do not require additional scholarship application. To be considered for scholarship, students must be admitted.

RESIDENT LIVING

All freshmen and sophomores live on campus. Transfer students under the age of 21 spend one year in campus housing. Housing assignments are given priority based upon receipt date of completed housing application with \$50 housing deposit.
