## JOIN US TO CELEBRATE THE OPENING OF YOUR LIBRARY & LEARNING CENTER

Share an important milestone in Concordia's history as we open the doors of the new George R. White Library & Learning Center. To celebrate, Concordia is hosting a free Community Open House, Saturday, August 29, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The family-friendly event will feature tours of the Library & Learning Center, free smoothie samples in Cafe 1905, a story time in the Jody Thurston Northwest Center for Children's Literature, free blood pressure checks in the Robert & Virginia Hilken Family Nursing Center, a performance of Shakespeare's *Henry IV: Part One* by the Portland Actors Ensemble at 3 p.m., and much more. Neighbors can also stop by the main desk on the first floor of the Library & Learning Center to apply for their free library card.

The 74,000 square-foot, state-of-the-art, anticipated Gold LEED certified facility is destined to become the heart and hub of the Concordia campus, and an important resource for the community. It includes a community room dedicated for neighborhood use, classrooms, community computers, and will be home to six academic centers. In addition, the increased space allows for 200,000 books and other library resources, doubling the size of the current collection.
