I wanted to take this opportunity to tell you about a scholarship you may not know about: **The Concordia University Leadership Scholarship**. This scholarship is reserved for students who will be significant contributors to campus life and student leadership at Concordia. If you have demonstrated that potential through leadership in your community, church, and/or school involvement, this scholarship is for you!

I encourage you to apply for the Leadership Scholarship, which has an **application priority deadline of May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012**. The scholarship ranges up to \$1,000.00 a year, and is automatically renewed for each year you attend Concordia University-Portland.

Eligibility for scholarship consideration also requires submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Please include Concordia as a recipient of your Student Aid Report with the CU school code '**003191**'.

To be considered for the scholarship, please submit all three following items in one envelope:

- A **resume** listing:  
significant school, church, and community activities  
awards and/or honors.
- An **essay** responding to Concordia's mission statement, "*Concordia is a Christian University preparing leaders for the transformation of society,*" identifying and explaining three aspirations you have which could be achieved by enrollment at Concordia University. This should be a typed response of one or two pages. Please include your name and social security number.
- The leadership scholarship **recommendation form**.

Scholarships will be based on merit as well as financial need. Scholarship applicants who submit by priority deadline will be notified of the results within the months of March or early April 2011.
