Admission Requirements

Admission is based on work history, evidence of managerial proficiency, academic ability, and leadership potential. Minimum requirements for MBA program admission include the following:

- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- An undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or better in your last 60 semester credits of undergraduate college coursework.
- Professional work experience of five or more years is recommended.
